## **Financial Information**

### **Tuition & Fees** (For the 2009-2010 school year)

**Tuition and fees is \$9000 per High School student for each student in Grades 9-12.** Student fees pay for a student copy of the yearbook, literary magazine, and student planner; Parents Association dues, class dues, school-wide testing costs, EDLINE, technology, and support for the student life, campus ministry and athletic programs. **Books, supplies, and uniforms are purchased and paid for separately.**

### **Financial Discounts**

**\$1000** for the second and each subsequent High School student's tuition. High School and Elementary School students may not be combined for the multiple student discount.

Saints Peter and Paul Parish offers a **\$500 per Parish family discount** (The Parish Discount is divided if a family has children in *both* schools). To qualify for the Saints Peter and Paul Parish Discount, the following criteria must be met:

- ✓ *You live within the boundaries of Talbot County.*
- ✓ *Your Parish Census Form is on file at the Parish Office and is complete with current information.*
- ✓ *The Parish Offertory envelopes must be used on a weekly basis.*

The Finance Office will review offertory contribution reports provided by the Parish Office and may remove the parish discount at any time if the above criteria are not met. As long as the above criteria are met, the parish discount will be offered on an annual basis.

The table below gives rates for the total tuition and fees for more than one High School student in a family.

	<i>Multiple Student Discount</i>	<i>With Full Parish Discount</i>
2 Children	\$17,000	\$16,500
3 Children	\$25,000	\$24,500
4 Children	\$33,000	\$32,500

### **Tuition Payment Options**

Families may pay tuition under the following options:

1. **Payment in Full due on or before July 1<sup>st</sup>.** This option entitles the responsible party to a 5% discount for cash payment or 2% for credit card payments on yearly net tuition and fees after all other applicable discounts. Payment may be made either through credit card, cash, personal check, cashier's check, or money order directly to the school.
2. **Extended Payment Plan through FACTS,** an independent tuition management service. For budgeting and convenience purposes, the responsible party may elect to spread payments over a period of 10 or 12 months.

### **Financial Assistance**

Both the Diocese of Wilmington and Saints Peter and Paul Schools have limited amounts of financial assistance available for families who meet financial criteria. Any family interested in pursuing financial assistance must complete the Diocesan/PSAS application. There is an application processing fee that is the responsibility of the applicant.
