School Profile

SCHOOL DESCRIPTION

Saints Peter and Paul High School is a Catholic, college preparatory, secondary school founded by Saints Peter and Paul Parish and the Dominican Sisters of New York in 1958. It is located in Easton on the Eastern Shore of Maryland, and serves over 190 students from grades 9 through 12.

FACULTY AND STAFF

Saints Peter and Paul High School has a faculty and staff of 25, 15 of whom hold Masters degrees or higher. The average teaching experience of the faculty is 15 years, and there is a teacher-student ratio of 8-1.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

The course of study is exclusively college preparatory. A tracking system for ability is used, consisting of four levels: *Academic*, *Honors* and *Advanced Placement*. Advanced Placement courses are offered in English Composition & Literature, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, United States Government & Politics, United States History, Biology, European History, and Chemistry. An *Academic Catalog* is published annually with more detailed information.

CLASS RANK

Grades are reported on quarterly reports as the unweighted, numeric average. The GPA and Class Rank reported on transcripts are weighted according to the difficulty level of the course. The GPA is based on a 4.0 scale. The Advanced Placement and Honors courses are given additional weight towards Class Rank.
